

Main Dressing Station

Operating theatres are used to amputate smashed limbs; chest wounds were cleaned and plugged. All received an anti-tetanus injection. Patients were divided and moved separately to Casualty clearing Stations.

- French patients were collected by French ambulances and taken to French Hospitals.
- German wounded were taken to designated Casualty Stations
- Urgent cases of all ranks with abdominal wounds and head injuries were moved as a priority
