

Limited treatment was given here. Wounds were cleansed and re-dressed, morphine given where necessary. Treatment labels were tied to patients. German prisoners were sometimes used to carry stretchers and clear up soiled dressings. Walking wounded passed down the chain of Advanced Dressing Stations to a Divisional collecting post. From here they were taken to a Designated Casualty Clearing Station. Those unable to continue walking were taken by ambulance to the Main Dressing Station.
